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### **PRIORITIES OF ENTREPVET**

ENTREPVET aims to upskill teachers, trainers, and youth workers by developing a successful youth entrepreneurship digital training curriculum. The key points fort his purpose are

- develop digital training methods for teachers, trainers, mentors
- motivation
- base hubs with a focus on the aims of participants
- learning by doing
- VET trainers/young people involved in designing the curriculum
- create mentor networks to inspire and motivate young people
- provide links to professional support
- develop communication skills
- provide clear aims and connections with other structures as well as a vision for the future (sustainability)
- open and regular dialogue with the target group and stakeholders
- clearly defined roles for stakeholders and mentors
- continuous focus on lessons learned
- actively learn from pilot projects run in different countries


