## Entrepvet - a Programme of Possibilities

The not-for-profit company WSX Enterprise, that advises companies on their business development, invites you to the Multiplier Event within the Erasmus+ Project Entrepreneurship Practices in VET – ENTREPVET which takes place on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> March in the Aldershot Enterprise Centre.

During the meeting stakeholders will learn about the programme and it's successes.

Entrepvet is a European funded project that started in 2021 and will end in May 2023 and which enabled creating entrepreneurial hubs in local communities. The aim of the project is to upskill workers who then, work to decrease the number of (at-risk) NEETs by improving their employability through a co-created entrepreneurship training programme that enhances both digital and entrepreneurial skillsets.

There are seven project Partners representing the UK, Turkey, Italy, Greece, The Netherlands and Romania who took part in the programme.

Project Co-ordinator at WSX Adriana Crear said: "We are very proud to have been a part of this Erasmus+ project. Over a period of 2 years WSX created two stable Entrepreneurial Hubs that allowed the project's learners, an access to an expert knowledge which covered Entrepreurship and digital literacy."

Within the project the Partners have created several learning modules around Networking, Communication, Social entrepreneurship and Gamification. The partners have created a Digital Toolkit which can be used and adapted by all those who wish to use social media and internet for work and beyond.

WSX Enterprise also provided a module on how to create Entrepreneurial Hubs which allowed other Partners to open hubs in their respective countries by using LANS framework: location – accessibility-need-support,
